

The program, supported by Sopra Steria, is also imbibing new methods through which the direct benefit for the families can be measured in more quantitative terms. The production centre is an introduction into the program which is benefitting the families in monetary terms.

Imbibing confidence through 'PRAYAS'

Prayas Program, an initiative of Barclays Sky Branch Team to build up the confidence and develop the entrepreneurial skills amongst the ladies. The program has been launched with an objective of empowering the ladies to become self-reliant and be able to support their families through a consistent income. The program had helped the trainees to start their tailoring units by giving them sewing machines. Reaching new scales through 'Production Centre'

After benefitting a considerable number through the stitching program, the demand for sustaining the families through income generation arises. In this connection, the production work has been started in both the stitching centers.

Tigri centre had taken up the work of stitching logos of a school on the shirts and the ladies earned a considerable income through the activity. In addition, they also made some bags which were sold through corporate exhibitions, events & exhibitions. On the other hand, the Hoshiyarpur centre had taken up the job work of stitching the student uniform of OM Foundation School.

The employment scheme not only provided an extra income to the families but also brought confidence in them.
