After School Remedial Program

Analyzing the community for over a decade, it has been observed that the students who lack proper mentoring may not be able to perform well in their subjects. To over come this, various tuition classes mushroomed but they too are not able to fulfill the real need of the students. Also, most of the students studying in govt. Schools cannot afford such tuitions. To fulfill this need, a cumulative program is required.

To meet this growing need, OM Foundation partnered with Global Logic to start the 'After School Remedial Program' for the students of nearby Government Schools. The program is designed to enhance the basic subject knowledge of the students studying in Government Schools. The prime focus of the project is to assist the students on the major subjects which will increase their understanding leading to good score on theirmark sheets.

The program aims to empower the students through proper mentoring, s ubject tuitions, extracurricular activities and exposure to the world outside. The emphasis has been given to the major subject tuitions along with strengthening the English communication and communication of the students. Exposure to the corporate world as well as involvement in extracurricular activities is being ensured through their active participation in various events. Functions and meets are essential part of the program which will help in the holistic development of the child.



A new level for the 1st batch students

1st batch students of OM Foundation completed their school education this year and entered the tougher phase of life. The decade of hard work is showing the results. 7 out of 10 girl students were able to get themselves enrolled for the full time graduation program in Delhi University, while 2 others have made their ways to the residential Banasthali University. OM is supporting these girls through monthly scholarship. 3 out of 15 boys got enrolled for professional courses in different colleges. 4 other boys were able to get a decent job, while others are completing their graduation through Delhi University's School of Open Learning, while sustain themselves and their families through a part time job. OM is additionally supporting these students through skilling & mentoring.

Mentoring of class XII

To enhance the in depth subject knowledge of the students of OM Foundation School pursuing higher education, an extra mentoring with proper remedial is required. Towards this, the students' grooming has been ensured through subject tuitions by subject experts post their school hours and mentoring by industry experts. Barclays has been a continuous supporter of OM Foundation and the team from Barclays visits regularly for mentoring the students of commerce stream.

Crash Course for class XI

The 3rd batch of OM Foundation made us proud with 100% pass results. Now to nurture the bright skills at the very right moment, OM initiated the Foundation Classes for skilling them for various entrance examinations. The program ensures that proper understanding will be inculcated among the bright students who are hard working and committed for their bright future.

OM is envisioning its students in the top colleges of India and is determined to do so.

Empowerment through Govt. Skilling Program

After successfully training the women with stitching skills, the need for further enhancing the skills has been observed. It has been further observed that a job assistance and govt accredited certificate will enable them to get a decent job.

To meet this demand and to enable the women through different skill sets, OM Foundation in association with Barclays Shared Services joined hands with National Skill Development Corporation for a 3-months paid course. In this course, the women will be skilled with advanced computers, beautician.

Exposure visit to Samarpan, New Delhi

The ladies beneficiaries enrolled under stitching course of Women Empowerment Program were with the Samarpan team for an exposure cum training program. Samarpan is operating a similar model in VasantKunj, Delhi and the ladies learnt lessons of team building and good operational practices from the Samarpan Team.

Production Centre is growing, and its visible

The production centre is growing continuously with a good pace. With some dress material orders as welcome kit, the centre is getting regular orders of stitching yoga mats, covers for various other products & bags, which is increasing.

The production centre has been started with an objective to provide an extra source of income to the ladies so that they can support their families financially, thereby gaining an extra respect among other family members. The centre has been successful in reaching out to its set objectives and more colors is being expected in the near future.
