Through a series of assessment, it has been observed that the students, who were unable read properly the Hindi paragraphs initially, are now gaining confidence in Sanskrit Shlokas & English rhymes as well. The attendance of these students was exceptionally well and it's a great motivation for the program.

Exposure for cultural performance

Grooming the students means the holistic development of the child. This includes the participation and exposure to the co curricular activities. To nurture this, the students from government schools under the Remedial Education Program of OM Foundation were provided with a platform during the Annual Day of the Foundation to showcase their talent in dance, drama and singing. Production unit achieving new heights

The production centre is growing continuously with a good pace. With some dress material orders as welcome kit, the centre is getting regular orders of stitching yoga mats, covers for various other products & bags, which are increasing.

The production centre has been started with an objective to provide an extra source of income to the ladies so that they can support their families financially, thereby gaining an extra respect among other family members. The centre has been successful in reaching out to its set objectives and more colors are being expected in the near future.

17 girls have enrolled themselves for production related work. They have taken up a job of stitching clothes for the students of OM Foundation School financially supported by SopraSteria. Most of the beneficiaries worked part time and have generated a total of INR 20,500 in a short span of 3 months. After this achievement, more numbers are ready to join the production unit and the unit is ready to take regular orders.

Pinki: an inspiration for the young ladies

Pinki Jha is a resident of Hoshiyarpur, Noida and she has joined the Foundation December 2015. She completed her diploma program under the Karigari Program and remained closely associated with the Foundation for all sort of activities. She has undergone some workshops for money management and English speaking.
