Empowering women through livelihood

Going beyond just providing the stitching and tailoring skills to the ladies from underprivileged community, a need of livelihood generation has been felt. The long term objective of our women empowerment program is to empower the ladies of the nearby community to start their micro enterprises. The foundation has been serving as an incubation centre for these high aspiring ladies entrepreneurs.

In the quest, the Foundation worked with Barclays to provide assistance in getting these ladies a corporate job. During the process, 9 ladies have been successful in getting placed in some Delhi based companies.
