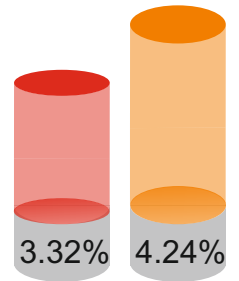

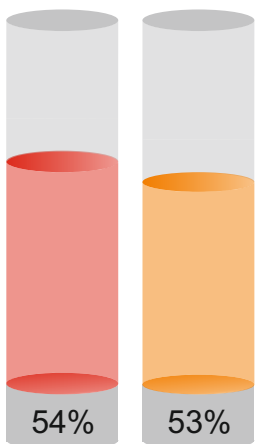

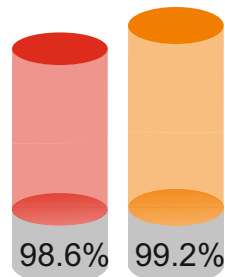
Average attendance



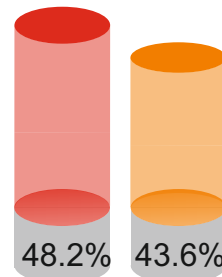

Daughter of a tempo traveller driver who is hardly sustaining his family of 6 in a mere INR 9000 a month. Sakshi joined nursery class in OM as an introvert child with strong & only focus on studies. The teachers later realized that she is good in art & activities, but she was not able to express herself. With dedicated efforts, she turned out to be an exceptional student both in academics and extra curricular activities. In the recent examinations, she scored 81% and stood third in the class. She is very popular among teachers and her classmates.

British Council TAs in OM Teaching Garden

In the quest to improve the teaching and learning for students, OM joined hands with the British Council, which supported the “Teaching Assistants” from UK. All this was the brainchild of our corporate partner, KPMG.

Mr. William Chambers & Mr Peter Dunford joined OM as the Teaching Assistants for a period of 6 months, with a motive to develop the understanding of English language. They believed that students should attain the foundation skills, particularly in grammar, spelling and pronunciation. For attaining these objectives, TAs helped pupils develop independent learning skills in an interactive way. They kept a check on the improvements in the teaching aids used. There was mutual sharing of teaching strategies like role play, music, creative writing, discussions and debates. They used to work with the teachers on lesson plans, with children to communicate in English and conduct remedial classes for slow learners. The students at OM were very fortunate to have these 2 TAs on board with them and would like to have more such interactions.

After School Remedial Program

After School Remedial Program has been spearheading the cause of providing the much needed support to the Government school students through remedial classes, computer education and improving the communication. While doing so, OM adopts the child-centred learning principal, which involves learning through activities and brainstorming among children.

The project was conceptualized to best utilize the available infrastructure for after school hours. The program got strengthening through the active involvement of corporate volunteering which not only boosted the confidence of the students, but also provided them the window to look after their future in a better way.

Equal emphasis is given towards the co scholastic development of the child. The extra curricular activities are prominently needed for these students as they lack any of these in both their schools and in their communities. A special focus is given on the personality development and early stage soft skills training of the students. The prime motive of this engagement is to equip the students with the qualities which make them stand away among the crowd.



As a part of the corporate engagement, the team from After School Program participated in Global Logic's sports Day and won various prizes in lemon race, sack race, spring race and many more. It was a very fulfilled and exuberant experience for all of them.

Aslam Alam

Creating his colorful world

A shining example of how collective efforts mixed with dedication can bring hopes to a life is the story of Aslam Alam. Aslam is a 14-year-old beneficiary of OM Foundation's After School Remedial program. He is a student of class 8th in Govt school in Noida and joined the program in the year 2016.

Son of a ricksha puller father, Aslam treats his low income background as his strength, as it motivates him to work hard and do good in life. His 5 other siblings are either not interested in studying or are not able to study due to the family hardship, but Aslam wants to acquire great skills and do something big. He is very much interested in art & craft. He loves painting and to making crafts. Apart from studies, Aslam has revamped his sports skills after joining OM and has developed himself as a good basketball player.

Aslam has great dreams for his future and we want to fill colors in his dreams. He believes in himself and we want to make sure that his self belief remains with him lifetime, because his self belief is the the most powerful weapon which can make him successful in his life.



Skill Development Program

Most of the children and young people from underprivileged communities still do not have the skills to actively participate and contribute in their own communities, often characterised by weak education systems, fewer employment opportunities and harmful practices passed down from generations. Many parents have never been in a position to provide the support their children need to break the inter-generational cycle of poverty and inequality.

Long lasting and enduring change will only be realized if we equip children and young students with the tools needed to engage with the challenges of the future. We, at OM, strongly believe that along with acquiring literacy, students need to acquire attitude, values and skills, and our mission through this program is to empower children, so that they can act as agents of change in their own lives for a more equitable world.

After training more than 100 beneficiaries, when we looked back, we found the students speaking their heart out in front of everyone, who were resistant to communicate among themselves earlier. OM is proud to be able to imbibe the needed confidence among youth in a very constructive way.

He was one of the few exceptional cases, where the promotion took place in such a short span. It was the result of his sheer dedication and honesty, which paid him at right time.

Nand Kishore dedicates his achievement to OM & his Skill Development trainer who helped him gain a focus on his overall development, but we know that it was already inside him. He has got all the qualities which were needed for his development. OM was fortunate to got the opportunity to imbibe the needed confidence and give the right direction to this young champion.

We, at OM, are fortunate to have good people joining in asll their capacities. Moving a step further, two of our well wishers have taken up the advisory role with their full potential. Women Empowerment Program

The Women Empowerment Program started in 2012 analyzing the dilemma of the young girls in the community. In the last 5 years, OM Foundation has trained over 600 ladies in Apparel Training and Secretarial Practices at the training centre located in OM School. Under Apparel Training, the ladies learnt stitching, sewing, tailoring & designing various dresses. Under Secretarial Practices, these women were given training and sessions on financial management, risk management and they were equipped with employable skill sets so that they can ascertain themselves, their family and their self needs. Due to this involvement of OM, the ladies and girls in the community have now become self reliant, self sufficient and independent. Many ladies have started their venture sustaining themselves and giving employment to others as well.

Mamta, the 18-year-old girl live in a slum in Hoshiyarpur. Her father is a rickshaw puller with a big responsibility of 6 children. To shed off the responsibilities, it is a regular tradition of marrying the girl child at an early age and same was the case with Mamta. Mamta wanted to complete her studies, but her parents didn't have money for this. They had money for her marriage but not for her studies.

Mamta joined the Women Empowerment Program of OM to avoid the marriage for few months, but very soon her hard work impressed the trainer Geeta, who brought Mamta into the production centre of the unit, where Mamta started earning, thereby continuing her studies. The financial sustainability brought power into her and soon she got the confidence to say no to her marriage. After an initial resistance and seeing the progress of their daughter's very own stitching centre, her parents agreed with her decision. Mamta, who once was struggling for her own, is now a role model for her community and the girls are seeking her advice for their growth. It is a mountainous impact of the program.
