


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This **Q3 edition of OM Foundation's newsletter** shares key progress and impact from the past quarter through **stories of our students, teachers, partners and community.**



ACADEMIC EXCELLENCE



FLN Program Initiated to Strengthen Learning Foundations

A Foundational Literacy & Numeracy (FLN) program was initiated in Grades 1-2 with a structured and outcome-driven approach. A comprehensive rubric was developed to clearly define learning benchmarks, followed by a baseline assessment. The assessment offered clear insights into students' current competencies, helping educators identify learning gaps and plan targeted instructional support.

Learning Comes Alive: Math & Science in Action

On National Mathematics Day, students at the Morning School's Science and Math Exhibition showcased working models and explained key mathematical and scientific concepts. Later, Afternoon School students presented interactive games and hands-on activities demonstrating concepts from algebra, trigonometry, and probability.



Building with AI: When Students use AI to solve Real Problems

Artificial Intelligence was introduced to Grade 8 students with the support of our partner EXL, culminating in capstone projects that applied their knowledge to real-life use cases. Students worked in teams to design innovative solutions using ChatGPT, Lovable and other AI tools. For eg. one group created a web application to report bullying. The project addressed the challenge of underreporting, highlighting the importance of early intervention. Through this project, students gained hands-on experience in using AI and digital tools to bring meaningful changes.

Hands-on Project-based Learning (PBL) on Waste Management

Our students from Grade 7 participated in an interactive Project-Based Learning experience on waste management. They explored different types of waste, conducted a school-wide survey, and held insightful interviews. The project culminated in awareness-building through thought-provoking presentations with detailed analysis and practical and simple solutions.

1 Enhanced Student Nutrition with Feeding India

This quarter saw the introduction of a new winter menu focused on protein-rich meals and fresh salads for improved student nutrition.



2 Mindfulness with the Art of Living

Students participated in an Art of Living workshop on pranayama techniques and meditation to promote stress management, calmness, and life skills.



3 Student Exchange with Prakriti School

Students from Prakriti School engaged with our Grade 8 and 9 learners in a meaningful dialogue on child rights, neurodiversity, cyber safety, and gender & identity.




4 Student Well-Being: Mental Health Assessment

One-on- one Career Counselling and Exposure

We conducted one-on-one career counselling for senior grade students, providing personalized guidance. Some students also attended the Global Career Fair at Pragyan School, Greater Noida, gaining insights into global education pathways and career options.

Teachers' Highlights


Training Sessions on Concept Mapping & Class Management


