EXECUTIVE SUMMARY



This quarter has been marked by exceptional achievements across academic, cultural, and extracurricular domains. Our students have excelled in national competitions, alumni have demonstrated remarkable career progress, and our partnerships continue to create meaningful impact.

- **3 corporate partner visits** engaging 46 representatives from EXL

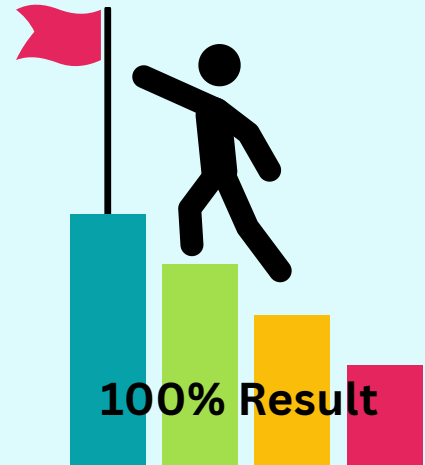

Overall Performance

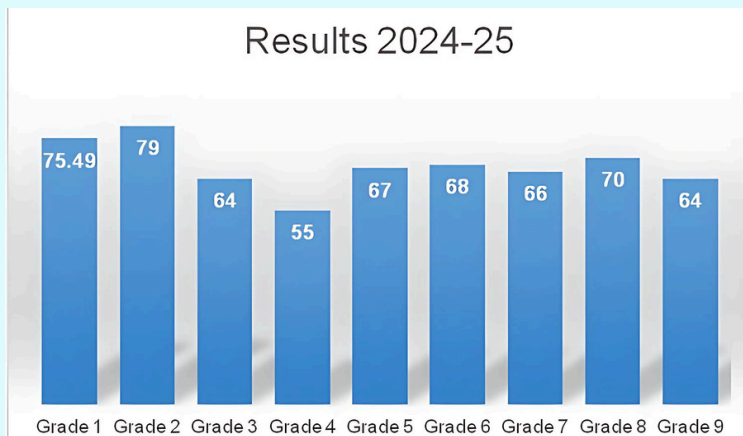
100% PASSING RATE ACHIEVED

Our students have demonstrated exceptional academic diligence with a perfect passing rate across all classes, reflecting our commitment to quality education and personalized learning support.

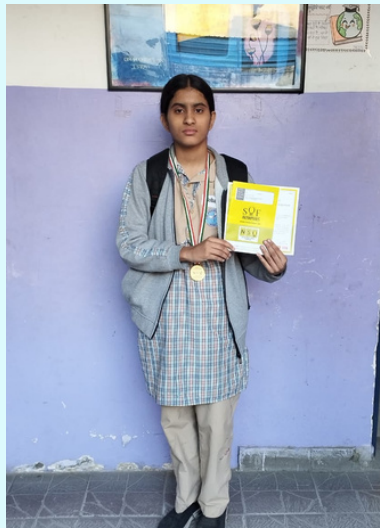


Results (Morning School)

Alumni Meet 2.0

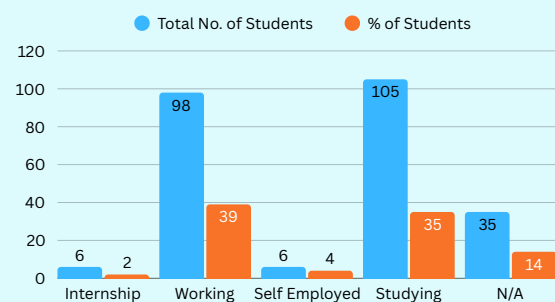

Alumni Success Statistics

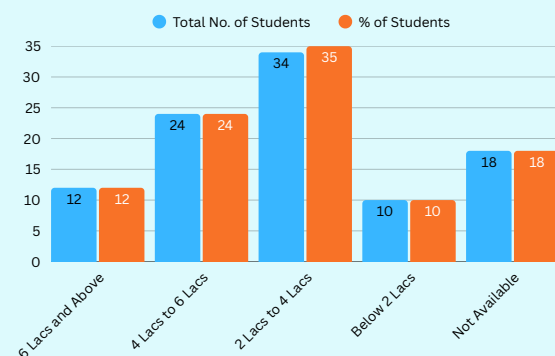
Out of **250 total alumni**:

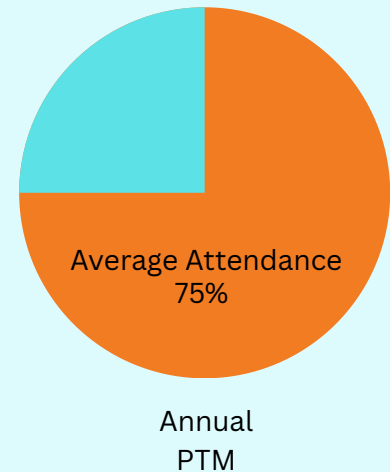
Jyoti Kumari –

Student's Fun Day

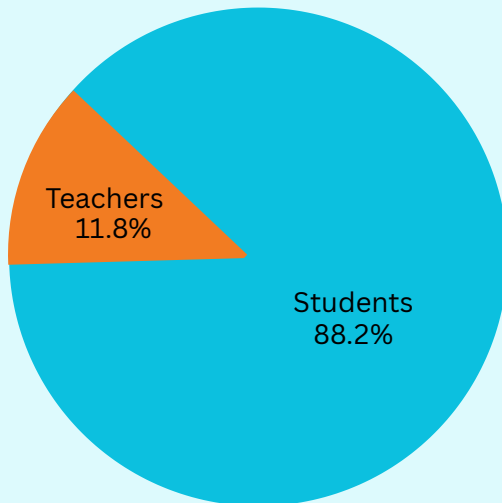
KPMG organized an outing for students and teaching staff to watch the motivational movie "Chandu Champion," highlighting themes of perseverance, determination, and overcoming challenges.

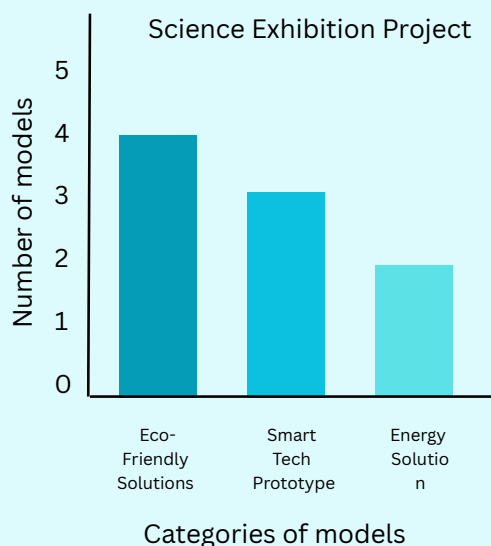
Science Live Models Exhibition
