# **NEW YEAR CELEBRATIONS**


#### THANK YOU FOR YOUR SUPPORT!


### SESSION ON COMMUNICATION SKILLS BY EXL

The motive of this session was:


- To understand the concepts of interpersonal communication.

We may not be together physically, but the bond always remains intact.We Look forward to bright future of these young and innovative children.


## HAND-MADE DIYAS


