

Road safety is something important that has to be followed at all times to ensure the safety of the operators of a vehicle, passengers, and pedestrians.



GAINING KNOWLEDGE OF FINANCES


Students at OM Foundation recently attended an Online Financial Literacy Session, conducted in collaboration with **Vittshala SRCC.**

SULEKHA PRASAD CLEARED RRB PO EXAM


PROUD MOMENT FOR OM FOUNDATION!




KEEPING SAFETY INTACT!
