#### Improved Computer Curriculum



This year, we partnered with Imbue Education for this project with the objective of re-designing the Computer curriculum as a skill with practical application for the students of Grade 4th – 8th. The Features of the Curriculum include hands-on experience, social skills, personalised growth and real-life projects. Our Teacher at Om Foundation implemented the program under Imbue mentorship. Our computer teacher was trained in experiential Pedagogy. Project-based learning helped the students to understand the applications of their learning. The outcome of this project was that the students learned computational thinking and are now able to create software and applications to improve efficiency. Some students have created applications such as Talk to Me App, Pedometer App, etc. with a little guidance from the teacher.

#### **Teacher's Interventions**



This year, we encouraged our teachers to begin implementing interventions in their classrooms. For the students, something out of the textbooks. As a result, primary school teachers began their interventions on topics such as social-emotional learning, where they discussed simple emotions and expressed gratitude through show-and-tell activities. Some teachers have begun to teach their students about healthy food and eating habits.


#### Handmade Books by students

#### Portuguese Language Certification


