This competition was won by the students of Dr. Kalam House.

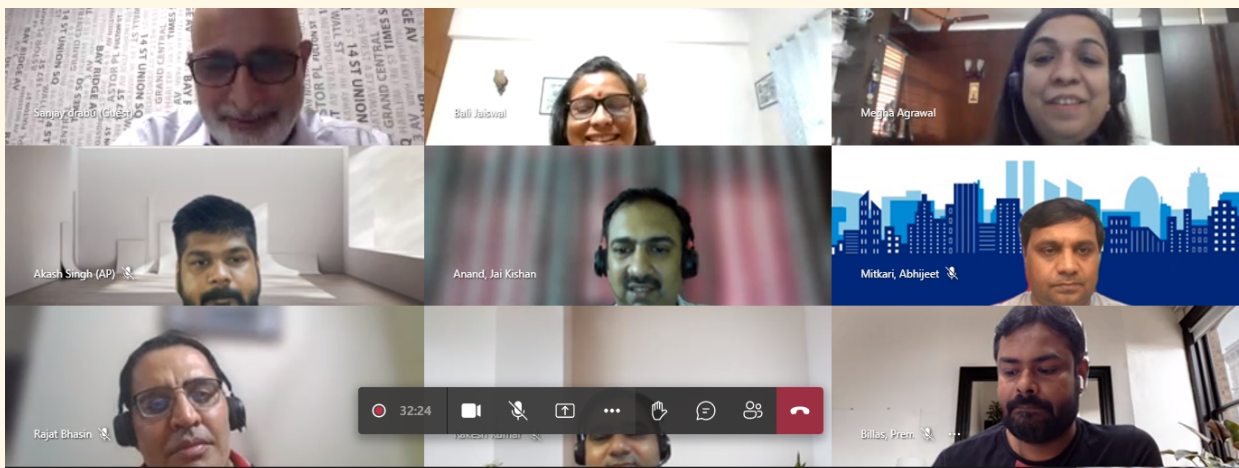


## Mini School Library

# Firefly 2022

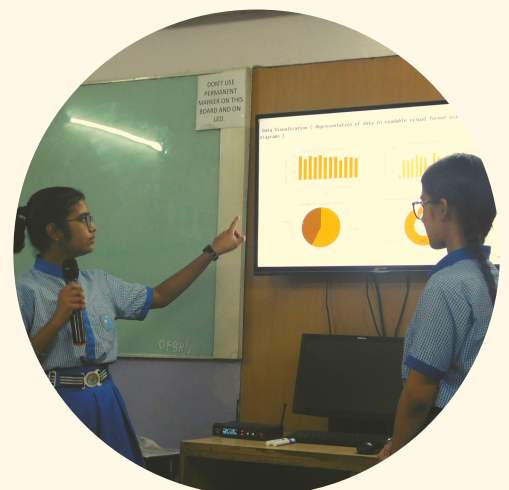
OM Foundation organised Firefly 2022, an annual event where our students got a chance to showcase their skills and knowledge on computers by building applications like:

- Introducing Data Science & Front Office Operations for the students of Class 9th & 10th as a skill subject.

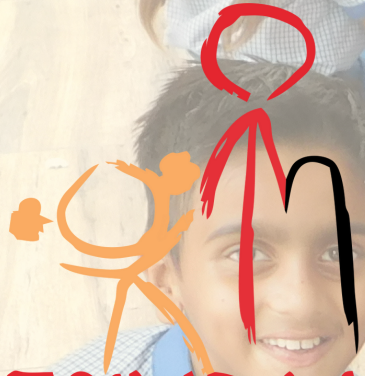
## Plan for Afternoon School
