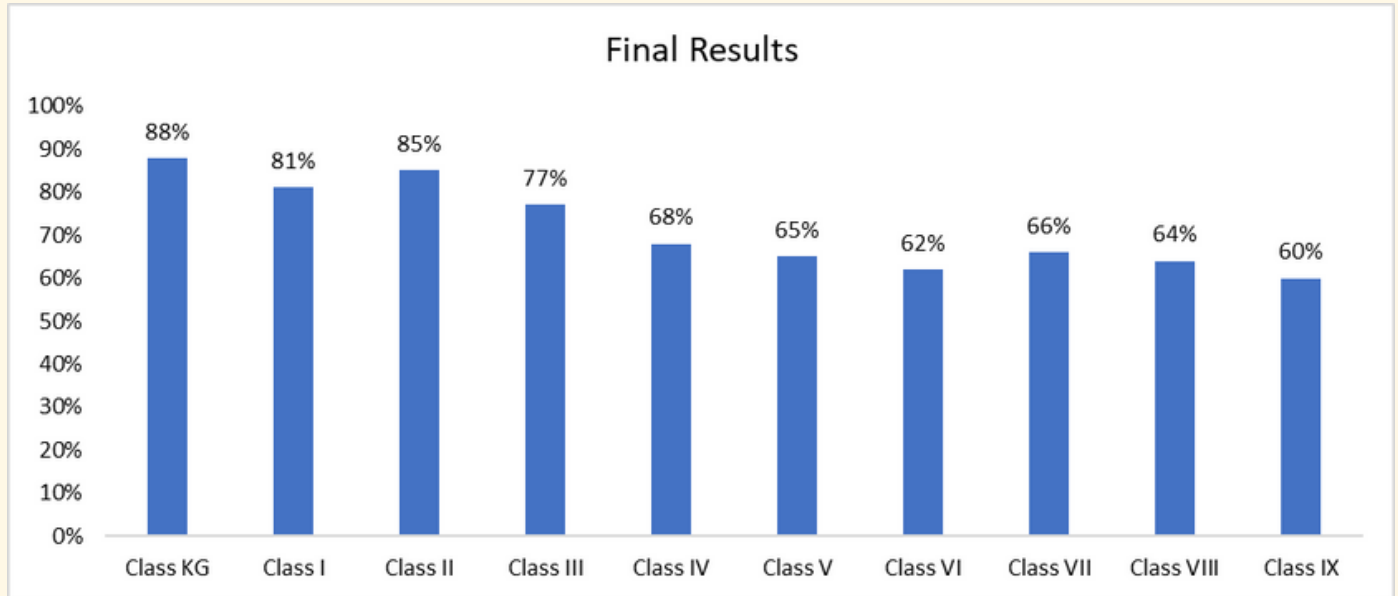
## Teachers' Training Workshop
